## **Course Objectives**

## 1. Summary of the main learning outcomes for students enrolled in the course.

The listening components of this course are designed for beginners. The students are taught the importance of the mechanics of speech, i.e. intonation, rhetoric, pitch, and their effects on meaning. The emphasis is on note-taking and understanding contextual clues. Because the listening course is meant for prospective interpreters and translators, students are trained to pay attention to what they listen to, to practice quick storage of language and content in memory, and to exhibit speed in message retrieval. The course seeks to develop and foster the following skills:

- 1. understanding the main and secondary ideas of listening material
- 2. improving students' developmental skills approach that encourages speaking, listening, writing, and reading abilities through a wide variety of exercises.
- 3. taking notes on specific information
- 4. to discern subtle differences of ideas and shades of meanings
- 5. introducing students to a wide range of exercises designed to get students to talk about their ideas, their everyday lives, and their environment.
- 6. identifying stated illocutionary forces
- 7. differentiating fact from opinion
- 8. inferring main ideas
- 9. to perceive implicit as well as explicit relationships between words, sentences and ideas
- 10. recognizing valid arguments and draw logical inferences and conclusions.
